

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (NTRO7051) affecting the Halvergate Road from its junction with Church Road for 1200m northwards in the PARISH OF REEDHAM to facilitate ducting and cable works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 18<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2023 for the duration of the works expected to be about 5 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Church Road, Mill Road, New Road, The Hills, Riverside, Station Road, Freethorpe Road, Reedham Road, The Green, Lower Green, Halvergate Road (Freethorpe, Halvergate, Reedham).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
